



## **2021 National Patient Safety Goals Official “Do Not Use” List ISMP’s List of Confused Drug Names**

The purpose of the National Patient Safety Goals is to improve patient safety. The goals focus on problems in health care safety and how to solve them. The Joint Commission’s 2021 National Patient Safety Goals set forth clear guidelines for how healthcare organizations can improve the quality of care.

# 2021 Hospital National Patient Safety Goals

The purpose of the National Patient Safety Goals is to improve patient safety. The goals focus on problems in health care safety and how to solve them.

## Identify patients correctly

NPSG.01.01.01

Use at least two ways to identify patients. For example, use the patient's name *and* date of birth. This is done to make sure that each patient gets the correct medicine and treatment.

## Improve staff communication

NPSG.02.03.01

Get important test results to the right staff person on time.

## Use medicines safely

NPSG.03.04.01

Before a procedure, label medicines that are not labeled. For example, medicines in syringes, cups and basins. Do this in the area where medicines and supplies are set up.

NPSG.03.05.01

Take extra care with patients who take medicines to thin their blood.

NPSG.03.06.01

Record and pass along correct information about a patient's medicines. Find out what medicines the patient is taking. Compare those medicines to new medicines given to the patient. Give the patient written information about the medicines they need to take. Tell the patient it is important to bring their up-to-date list of medicines every time they visit a doctor.

## Use alarms safely

NPSG.06.01.01

Make improvements to ensure that alarms on medical equipment are heard and responded to on time.

## Prevent infection

NPSG.07.01.01

Use the hand cleaning guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention or the World Health Organization. Set goals for improving hand cleaning. Use the goals to improve hand cleaning.

## Identify patient safety risks

NPSG.15.01.01

Reduce the risk for suicide.

## Prevent mistakes in surgery

UP.01.01.01

Make sure that the correct surgery is done on the correct patient and at the correct place on the patient's body.

UP.01.02.01

Mark the correct place on the patient's body where the surgery is to be done.

UP.01.03.01

Pause before the surgery to make sure that a mistake is not being made.

# Official “Do Not Use” List

- This list is part of the Information Management standards
- Does not apply to preprogrammed health information technology systems (i.e. electronic medical records or CPOE systems), but remains under consideration for the future

Organizations contemplating introduction or upgrade of such systems should strive to eliminate the use of dangerous abbreviations, acronyms, symbols and dose designations from the software.

Q.O.D., QOD, q.o.d, qod (every other day)	Period after the Q mistaken for "I" and the "O" mistaken for "I"	Write "every other day"

<sup>1</sup> Applies to all orders and all medication-related documentation that is handwritten (including free-text computer entry) or on pre-printed forms.

**\*Exception:** A “trailing zero” may be used only where required to demonstrate the level of precision of the value being reported, such as for laboratory results, imaging studies that report size of lesions, or catheter/tube sizes. It may not be used in medication orders or other medication-related documentation.

## Development of the “Do Not Use” List

In 2001, The Joint Commission issued a *Sentinel Event Alert* on the subject of medical abbreviations. A year later, its Board of Commissioners approved a National Patient Safety Goal requiring accredited organizations to develop and implement a list of abbreviations not to use. In 2004, The Joint Commission created its “Do Not Use” List to meet that goal. In 2010, NPSG.02.02.01 was integrated into the Information Management standards as elements of performance 2 and 3 under IM.02.02.01.

# ISMP List of *Confused* Drug Names

This list of confused drug names, which includes look-alike and sound-alike name pairs, consists of those name pairs that have been published in the *ISMP Medication Safety Alert!*<sup>®</sup> Acute Care or the *ISMP Medication Safety Alert!*<sup>®</sup> Community/Ambulatory Care newsletters. Events involving these medications were reported to ISMP through either the ISMP National Medication Errors Reporting Program (ISMP MERP) or ISMP National Vaccine Errors Reporting Program (ISMP VERP). We hope you will use this list to determine which medications

require special safeguards to reduce the risk of errors. This may include strategies such as: using both the brand and generic names on prescriptions and labels; including the purpose of the medication on prescriptions; configuring computer selection screens to prevent look-alike names from appearing consecutively; and changing the appearance of look-alike product names to draw attention to their dissimilarities. Both the FDA-approved and the ISMP-recommended tall man (mixed case) letters have been included in the list below.
